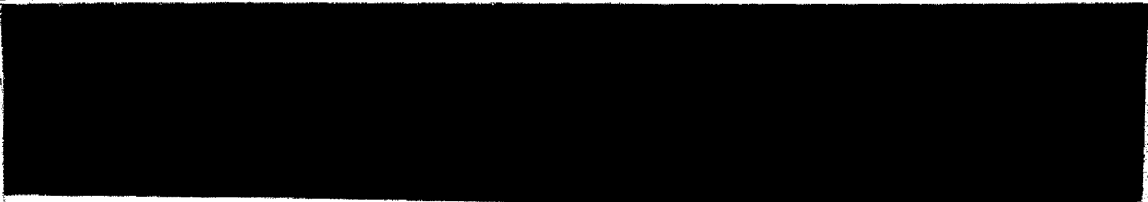

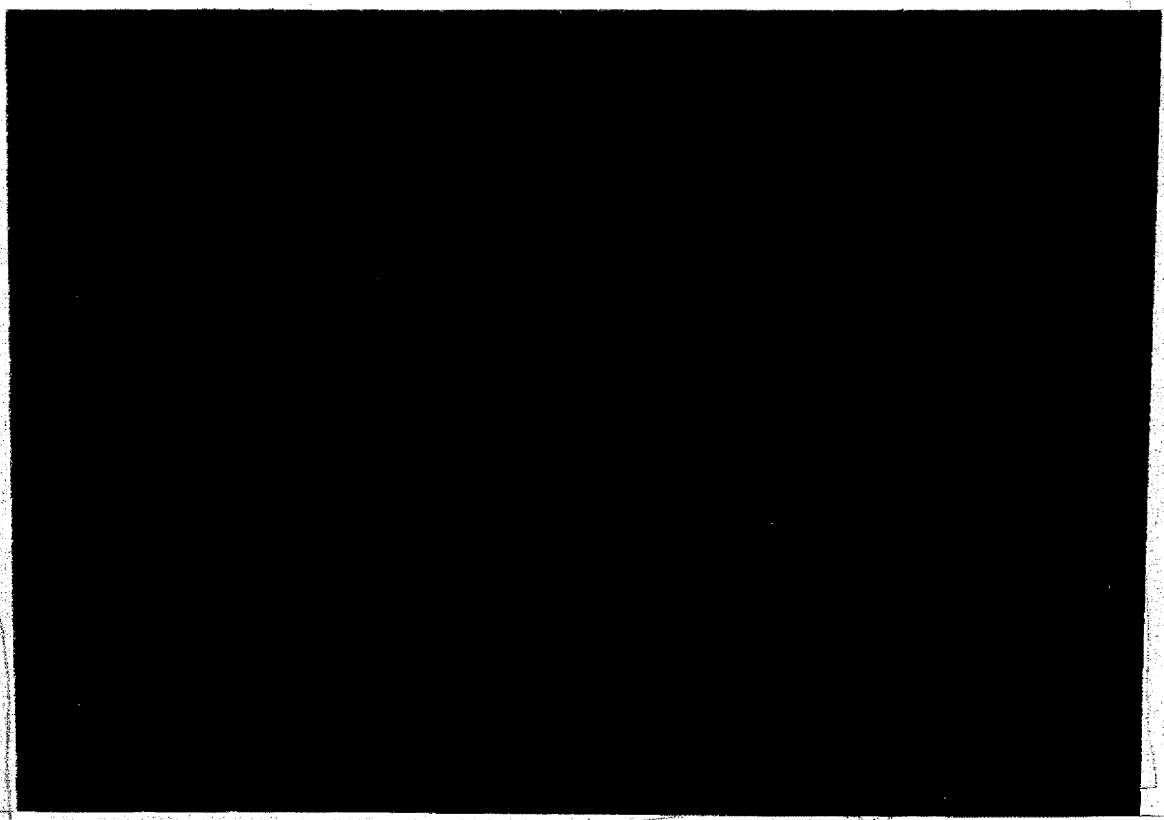
1. To approve the withdrawal from the stockpile of weapon components for Operation Sandstone.

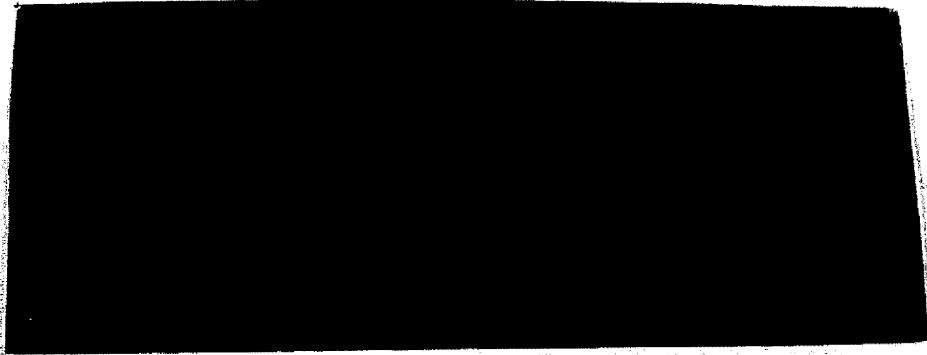

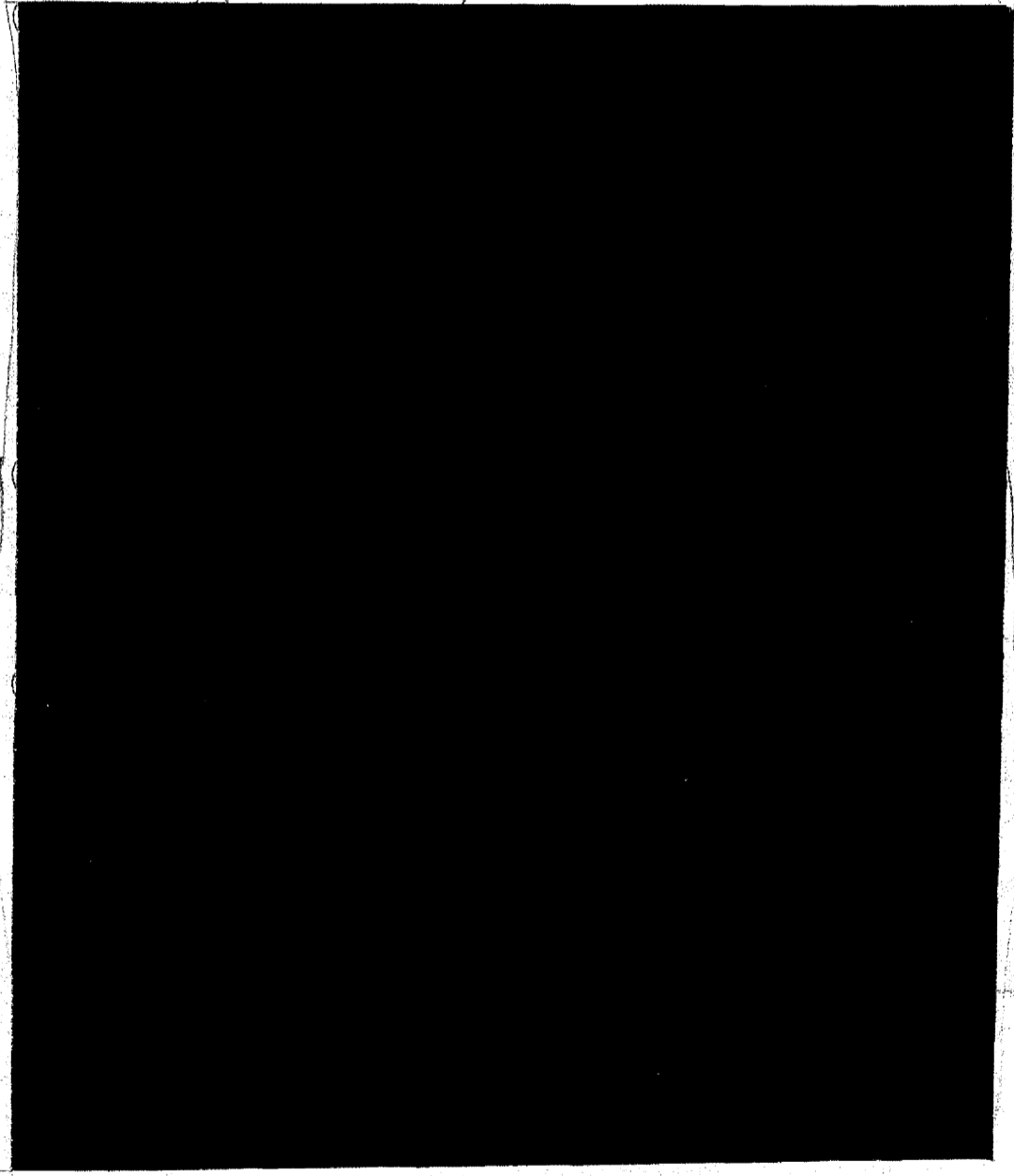
