Dear Admiral Burke:

It is a pleasure to report that the sixth follow-up medical examination of the Marshallese Islanders has been successfully completed and the personnel of the team are preparing their data for publication.

Preliminary analyses of their data indicate that no untoward clinical effects have occurred in the population although there has been a slight increase in the body burden of certain radioactive nuclides.

Dr. Robert A. Conrad, leader of the team, has written that Lt. V. E. Kessiter USN, Commanding Officer of the USN HVAL COUNTY (LST 758), and the officers and crew of the ship cooperated in every way possible and contributed greatly to the success of the expedition.

Dr. Conrad has also asked us to note the outstanding assistance rendered the team by several other Navy personnel. Commander I. V. King (USC) USN served as a most effective Navy Liaison Officer in the Washington area. Captain C. F. Van der Aar USN, Commanding Officer of the Naval Medical Research Institute, supported the mission to the Solomons and at Hawaii, Captain Harry Flier (USC) USN was a most efficient Liaison Officer to the Commander-in-Chief of the Pacific Fleet. At Saipan the Commanding Officer, Captain Alfred L. Cope USN, cooperated in every possible way and particularly in arranging for air support of the Operation Houghday. Commander J. E. Meyer (USC) USN, the senior medical officer at Saipan, was also extremely helpful.
