Reference is made to the following:

a. Letter DASALG 600.1, this headquarters, 16 August 1963, to Mr. Jose A. Benites, Deputy High Commissioner, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, P. O. Box 542, Agana, Guam, M. I., copy of which was furnished the Department of the Interior.

b. Letter from the Deputy High Commissioner, 11 June 1964.

Paragraph 2 of reference a, as quoted below, is considered to be the Department of Defense's present position regarding future requirements for the real estate as listed in the agreement of 1 July 1960:

"The Department of Defense desires to continue the agreement for an indefinite period. There is no requirement for the temporary buildings on these islands, and since they have deteriorated to such an extent that they are a hazard and are of no monetary value, they are, by this action, transferred to the High Commissioner of the Trust Territory to dispose of as he sees fit under the provisions of Title IV, Section 402, Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended."
