This is to confirm our conversation of October 13, 1952 concerning the cooperation of the Canadian Weather Bureau with the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission in a program of collecting fallout following nuclear detonations. After discussions of the proper procedures, it was agreed that you would call Mr. Gipsiani at Chalk River and inform him of the proposed plan. The organization of stations would be handled by coordination between the United States and Canadian Weather Sursaus. The operation and the resulting data will be unclassified.
