SUBJECT: Subcontract 108 - Sixth Amendment

Attached for your execution and return of five copies is the Sixth Amendment to Subcontract 108.

As discussed, this Sixth Amendment will provide funds to cover the costs of maintaining eight men in the field at the Enivetok Proving Ground for approximately one month longer than was originally required. Accordingly, the requirements of Appendices B and D are changed and this amount of effort is added to the scope of work.

The additional bost will be as follows:

Allowable Direct Charges - \$23,273.36

Fee 66% - 1,396.40

Total Addition - \$24,669.76

The above that estimate is based upon men staying at EFC until June 30, 1956 and thereafter allowing five days for their return to your plant and completion of certain duties before reassignment to other work.

Accordingly, the Sixth Amendment increases the Estimates, Obligation of Funds and Fixed Fee as follows:
