SUBJECT: MARSHALL ISLANDS PROGRAMS AND EXPENDITURES

ASEV has requested that an overall program plan for EV activities in the Marshall Islands be prepared. In order to initiate such a plan, it would be most helpful if you or your staff could provide the following information for each project you support relative to EV activities in the Islands. If appropriate and adequate information is not already available within Headquarters, it may be necessary or desirable to request that field personnel prepare such material. (For example, the medical program at BNL is already well down this road. Also, LLL says that they can comply without impacting on ongoing activities.) This material should include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following:

1. Objectives of the project
2. Questions being answered
3. Protocols
4. Methodologies
5. Schedules, including milestones, decision points and deadlines
6. Interfaces with other related projects
 - a. Within the same lab
 - b. With other labs
7. Format of results
8. Method(s) of communicating results and to whom
9. Reporting requirements
10. Anticipated future directions, various options and levels of effort, including
 - a. Resources needed (funds, facilities, personnel, other)
 - b. Constraints (real or potential, of whatever nature)
 - c. Implications of each option, pro and con
 - d. Time factors
 - e. Decision points


11. Detailed cost estimates of the project for FY 1979 and anticipated funding requirements for each of the next three fiscal years. Include details both for the project itself and for any subcontracts.

Items (10) and (11) are of particular importance in anticipating the time when DNA will no longer be at Enewetak and when the Marshall Islands will no longer be administered via the Trust Territory (i.e., post-1981).

It would be appreciated if this material could be returned to me no later than June 4, 1979.
