REFERENCE YOUR DTG 200025Z CONCERNING MEDICAL RESURVEY AT RONGELAP. THE DIVISION OF BIOLOGY AND MEDICINE AND THE MEDICAL DEPARTMENT OF BROCKHAVEN HATICHAL LABORATORY HAVE REEXAMINED THE ADVISARILITY OF RESURVEYING THE WHOLE BODY CONTAMINATION BURDENS OF THE MARSHALLESE DURING MAY. ALL CONCERNED BELIEVE THAT THE PROMPTROT RESURVEY POSSIBLE IS IN BEST INTERESTS OF ALC. STATE, INTERIOR, AND DOD. THE POSSIBLE CHANGES INDUCED IN THE ENVIRONMENT BY A FEW SHOTS MAY WELL NOT HAVE INFLUENCED THE NATIVES APPRECIABLY BY THE TIME THE RESURVEY CAN BE MADE. ON THE OTHER HAND, IF THE BEGINNING CHANGES ARE CESERVED (BASED ON MEMORY OF THE ORIGINAL LOST DATA), IT MAY TURN OUT TO BE MOST IMPORTANT THAT THEY BE DETECTED AND EVALUATED.
