3. ON MARCH 16 SECRETARY FULLES, WHEN QUESTIONED BY PRESS, CALLED IT "REGRETTABLE INDIDENT" ON WHICH HE DIT NOT WISH TO CONCERT WITH FULL INFORMATION LECELVEL.

ON MARCE 17, AMBASSAICE ALLISON TAR AUTHOLIZED TO ADVISE JAPANESE OCVERNMENT ALONG FOLLOFING LINES: "THE U.S. GOVERNMENT IS CLAVELY CONCERNED OVER REPORTS THAT SOME JAPAN.SE FISHERMEN HAVE SUPPLINED INJURY DURING THE COURSE OF ATOMIC THORS IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS. THE U.S. GOVERNMENT IS CONDUCTING AN INVECTIGATION IN C. PERATION WITH JAPANESE AUTHORITIES ON ALL WER FACTS IN THIS CASE. IN ORDER TO PERATION WITH THIS REGRETTABLE ACCIDENT COLURNED DISUITE THE COMPLETED IN C. PERATION WITH THIS REGRETTABLE ACCIDENT COLURNED DISUITE THE CAREFUL PERCENTIONS TAREN AND INCLUDING WARNINGS ISDUEL OVER A WIDE AREA. THE UNITED STATES IN THE PROFESSION OF THE PACTS WARMANT." DOE ARCHIVES

6. ON MATCH 18, ANDASSADOR ALLISON REPORTED THAT TWO OF THE JAPANESS FISHERMEN MOST SERIOUSLY AFFECTED NOR IN TWENSITY HOSPITAL AND 21 OTHERS IN HOSPITAL AT MAIZU. THE FISHING SHIP, FUKURIE MARU, WAS ANCHORDED OFF A PIER

AT YAIZU AND ACCESS QUARDED BY JAPANESE AUTHORITIES. ALLISON REPORTS THAT THE INCIDENT CONTINUES TO DOMINATE JAPANES: PRESS AND DIET DEBATES WITH DITREVE ENOTIONALISE. HE FURTHER REPORTS "OBVIOUS JAPANESE SCLINTISTS HAVE BEEN GIVEN FULL ACCESS AND SUFFICIENT TIME FOR INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATIONS PRIOR SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION WITH UNITED STATES. THERE INVESTIGATIONS APARENTLY DEGAN WITH AREJULI VASUE AND CONSIDERABLY BEFORE REBASSY RECEIVED NOTION OF INCIDENT OR INSTRUCTIONS. PRESS HAS SUGGESTIVE NATURE OF NUCLEAR OF THEREORUCHEAF WEAPON CAN BE DETERMINED BY ANALYSIS ASH AN PRINTED TOTAY HYPOTH.SIS OF NY ACCEN BORE BUILT WITH LITERAINED AND COMPETENCE JAPANESE SCIENTISTS HIGH, AND IT IS TROBABLE THEY WILL B. 7. ON MALCH 18, JAPANLES MENIOTER IN WASHINGTON LEFT "INFORMAL" NOTE WITH LEPARTMENT OF STATE SETTING POLTH ITS UNLARSTANEING OF THE CHRONOLOGY OF LVENTS AND ASKING SERIES OF QUISTIONS INCLUTING METHODS TAKEN TO ISCUE WARNINGS ANEAD OF SHOT. DEPARTEENT DOES NOT INTEND TO A EBPOND TO NOTE UNTIL ALL FACTS HAVE BEEN REPORTED BY THE ANGLESSADOR.

•. ON MARCH 19, AND/SOADOF REPORTED TO WASHINGTON THAT BE HAD I FUID THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT WHICH HAL BEEN COM UNICATE. TO THE PUBLICEN OFFICE: "I HAVE BEEN PLEASED TO LEARN OF THE PROLPT ACTION WHICH IS BLINE TAKEN BY BOTH JAPANEDE AND ANTHORITIES. TO PROVIDE THE MOST EFFECTIVE POSSIBLE MEDICAL AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THOSE AFFECTED BY THE ACCIDENT WEICH BEFELL THE FUKURIU MARU. THIS ASSISTANCE IS BEING OFFICIED OUT OF HUMANITARIAN CONCERN FOR THE DUJUREL CREW MEMBERS AND CONCERN FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY. I WISH TO FENEX THE DOE ARCHIVES ASSURANCES ALREADY GIVEN THAT UNFILE STATES CIVILIAN AND MILITARY PERSONNEL AND

FACILITIES IN JAPAN ARE AVAILABLE TO GIVE THE GENATEST POSSIBLE DEGREE OF ASSISTANCE TO THE JAPAN ASE AUTHORITIES, WHO HAVE ALREADY SHOWN THEMSELVES ALERT AND VIGOROUS IN LEADING WITH THE PROBLEM. OUR JOINT INVESTIGATIONS OF THE INCIDENT ARE ALREADY WELL UNDER WAY AND WIEL, I BELIEVE, LEAD TO FINDINGS WHICH WE CAN BOTH ACCEPT. IN ADVANCE OF THOSE FINITINGS, I AM AUTHORIZED TO MAKE CLEAR THAT THE UNITED STATES IS PREPARED TO TAKE FUCH STEPS AS WAY BE NEGROSSARY TO INSURE FAIR AND JUST COMPENSATION IF THE FACTS SO THREATT." PARAGRAPH. IN ADDITION, HE REPORTED THAT WORTON AND MEEKS AND FLYING TO TAIZU TO INSPECT HOSE TRALIZED SALLORS AND VESUEL AND "RELIDINARY REPORTS OF ABCC DOCTORS INDICATE LEGRED INJURIEF SUFFERED MAY BE LESS. THAN HAS BEEN R PORTED." B FAGRAPH. OUR SUGGESTED REVISION OF STATEMENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

"THE ROUTINE TESTS NOT UNDERWAY AT THE PACIFIC PROVING GROUNDS ARE CONCERNED WITH THE MOST RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN ATOMIC WAFLOSIVES. RESULTS TO DATE HAVE BEEN OF GREAT VALUE AND SIGFICANCE, SUBSTANTIALLY ADDING TO OUR KNOWL DGE OF ATOMIC WEAPONS AND TO OUR READINESS.

"THE EXPLOSIVE TIELS FROM A DEVICE RECENTLY TENTED WAS GREATE. THAN THAT OF ANY PREVIOUSLY DETONATED. THIS IS IN ACCORD WITH THE R COAD OF PREVIOUS TEST SURJES, WACH OF WHICH HAS REQULARLY SURPAS. ED THE RESULTS OF EARLIES ONES. OUR CONSTANT AIM IS TO OBTAIN THE MAXIMUM EFFICIENCY POSSIBLE FROM MUCLEAR MATERIAL, NOT ONLY IN ORDER THAT OUR ARMED FORCES MAY BE EQUIVATED WITH THE MOST EFFECTIV-DOE ARCHIVES WEAPONS, BUT ALSO DECAUSE SUCH RESERICH IS A POSITIVE WAY OF LEARNING WHAT A POSSIBLE ENEMY MIGHT BE CAPABLE OF DIRECTING AGAINUT US.

"THE FIRCT REPORT OF RADIATION INJURY TO A SMALL NUMBER OF RESIDENTS ON ALJACENT ISLAMES WAS EXAGGERATED. AS THE AEC HAS PREVIOUSLY STATED, GEN.RAL CLARKSON, CONSULMING THE TASK FORCE WHICH IS CONDUCTING THE TESTS, EVACUATED THE 236 RESIDENTS AND 28 TASK FORCE PERSONNEL SO SITUATED AND ALL ARE UNDE CAREFUL MEDICAL OBSERVATION AT EMAJALEIN. IN MEDICAL OPINION NO PERMANENT HARM TO THEM IS INDICATED. IN DUE COURSE THE RESIDENTS WILL BE RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES AND TASK FORCE PERSONNEL TO DUTY.

"I HAVE BEEN DEEPLY CONCERNED OVER THE REPORTS THAT SOME JAPANESE FISHER VEN HAVE SUFFERED INJURY DURING THE COURSE OF THE TESTS. OUR AMEASSADOR IN JAPAN IS CONDUCTING AN INVESTIGATION IN COOPERATION WITH THE JAPANESE AUTHORITIES TO OBTAIN ALL THE FACTS AND AMERICAN AUTHORITIES IN JAPAN ARE ASSISTING IN PROVIDING DEFECTIVE MEDICAL AND TECHNICAL AID TO THOSE AFFECTED BY THE ACCIDENT. THE AMERICAN AND AS ADOR HAS INFORMED THE OOVERNMENT OF JAPAN THAT THE UNITED STATES IS PREPARED TO TAKE SUCH STUPS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO INSURE FAIR AND JUST COUPENSATION IF THE FACTS SO WARRANT.

"NOTIFICATION OF LANGES AREA AR UNI THE PACIFIC PROVING GROUNDS WAS GIVEN TO THE UNILIE NATIONS IN 1947 AND THERAFTER AS CHANGES OCCURRED. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE ENTIRE AREA SUBJOURDING BIRINI AND ENIMETOK ATOLLS HAS BEEN PUBLICLY POSTER AS A DANGER AREA FOR SOME YEARS. RECENTLY THE DANGER AREA HAS BEEN AGAIN EXTENDED TAKING INTO ACCOUNT OUR LATEST EXPERIENCE. NOTIFICATION TO ALL SHIPPING DOE ARCHIVES WAS DISSEMINETED 20 MARCH 1950. MANGER AREA MOTICES HAVE BEEN AND ARE SPECIFICALLY DEPTNEE IN ATLAND MARINE NAVIGATIONAL PUBLICATIONS.

"BULLETIN WASHINGTON (AP) — THE UNITED STATES PROPOSED TO RUSSIA TODAY " A CONCRETE PLAN TO FURTHER THE PEACEFUL DEVELOPMENT AND USE OF AT MIC THEREY." PARAGRAPH. THE PLAN WAS HANDED TO SOVIET AMBASSADOR GEORGI N. ZARUBIN BY SECRETARY OF STATE DULLES IN A FIVE MINUTE MEETING IN BULLES OFFICE. PARAGRAPH. A STATE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCEMENT SAID ALSO THAT RUSSIA HAS GIVEN THE UNITED STATES "CENTAIN PROPOSALS" ON ATOMIC PROBLEMS, AND THAT THESE ARE UNDER STUDY. PRESEABLY THE SOVIET PROPOSALS" ON ATOMIC PROBLEMS, AND THAT THESE ARE UNDER STUDY. PRESEABLY THE SOVIET PROPOSALS AND FOR SOME KIND OF INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT TO BAN ATOMIC WEAPONS. PARAGRAPH. THE PLAN GIVEN TO ZARUBIN BY DULLES IS A DETAILED PROGRAM FOR CARLYING OUT THE PROPOSAL PRESIDENT EISENHOWER MADE IN AN ADDRESS TO THE UNITED NATIONS DEC. 8 FO. AN INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC POOL UNDER A WORLDWICH ATOMIC ENERGY ACENCY. THE BASIC PROVISIONS OF THE PROPOSAL ARE:

1. THAT THE UNITED STATES, EUSSIA, AND OTHER ATOMIC POWERS INCLUEING BRITAIN AND FRANCE SHOULD SET UP AN INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY.

2. LACH OF THE POWERS WOULD MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM ITS STOCKPILES OF URANIUM AND OTHER ATOMIC MATERIALS TO A POOL UNDER THIS AGENCY.

3. THE AGENCY WOULD BE RE PONSIBLE FOR STORING AND SAFLQUARDING THIS WATERIAL, PREVENTING SURPLISE SETZURD BY A BANDIT NATION BENT UPON ATOMIC WAR.

4. THE AGENCY WOULL BE AUTHORIZED TO MOBILIZE THE WORLD'S ATONIC EXPERTS TO DEVELOF THE USES OF ATONIC EN. GY FOR ELECTRICAL POSER IN POWER STARVED ARVAD OF THE WORLD AND FOR OTHER PEACEFUL PURPOSES.

TODAY'S STATE BEPARTMENT STATEMENT RECALLED THAT DILLES HAD TISONSED "PROCEDURAL METTERS" ON THE ATOMIC PROBLEM WITH ZARUBIN LAST ANUARY PRIOR TO DOE ARCHIVES THE BERLIN BIG-FOUR CONFERENCE, ANI THAT HE ALSO HAD THO PRIVATE TALKS WITH

BOVIET FOREGIN HINL TER MOLOTOV AT BERLIN.

"IN THESE TALKS AT BIRLIN," THE ANNOUNCEMENT SAIL, "IT WAS AGREED THAT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT FOR ITS PART WOULD SHORTLY TRANSMIT TO THE SOVIET OF VERNMENT IN WRITING A CONCRETE FLAR TO FURTHER THE PEACEFUL DEVELOEN...NT AND USE OF ATCHIC ENSEOT.

"THIS FROMOSAL HAS NOW BEEN PREPARED B. THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH OTHER PRIENDLY GOVERNMENTS CONCERNED. A COPY OF THE PROPOSAL WAS HANDLE TODAY TO THE SOVIET ANDASSANOR BY THE SECRETARY."

THIS MEANT THAT THE ATOMIC TALKS HAVE DEPTHITELY MOVED BON FROM WHAT DIPLOMATS CALL THE "PROCLEGRAL" PHASE INTO THE "SUBSTANTIVE" PHASE.

IN SHORT, THE UNITED STATES AN - RUSSIA ARE NO LONGER TALKING ABOUT HOW TO NEGOTIATE. THEY ARE NOW ACTUALLY NEGOTIATING ON THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC IN E GY PROBLEM END REF MANVEH
