Dear Sergeant **John J. ...**:  
The Army is pleased to receive your letter of February 22, 1954, regarding your application for a medical certificate to return to active duty. You stated that you were honorably discharged from the Army on September 10, 1950, and were currently a member of the National Rifle Association.

Your medical history shows that you have been free of any medical conditions since your discharge. You were seen by a general practitioner on February 1, 1954, at which time you were given a physical examination. The results of this examination are as follows: Height, 5 feet 10 inches; weight, 165 pounds; blood pressure, 120/80 mm Hg; heart rate, 72 beats per minute; lungs, clear; abdomen, soft and nontender; spine, normal.

Based on the above information, you are considered to be in good health and are eligible to return to active duty. You are recommended for a "fit" status for all military and naval service, and you are eligible for reenlistment in the Army. A copy of this report will be forwarded to the Surgeon General, Department of the Army, and the Adjutant General, Department of the Army, for their information.

Your medical records are being reviewed by the Medical Service Center, and a copy of the report will be made available to you upon request. You are advised that this report is for your information only and does not constitute a contract of service. The Army reserves the right to reassign you to any duty station and to require you to accept such assignment. Your return to active duty is subject to the availability of positions and the needs of the Army. You are also advised that you will be required to undergo a physical examination upon reporting to your new duty station.
