Your performance of duty reflects credit on you and on the Atomic Energy Commission and was a significant contribution to the success of the proof tests.

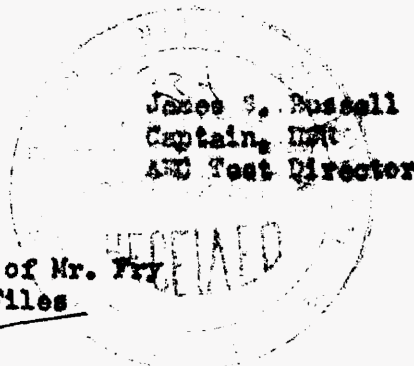
It has been a privilege to have you as a member of the Atomic Energy Commission's Proving Ground Group.
