

RICHOGICAL PROJECTS FOR FUTURE TESTS



Pursuant to your suggestion, we have prepared an outline of projects to be carried on in connection with the fallout problem of future tests. Mr. Gorman is proparing material on water contamination which will be included as a part of this outline. Provided these projects are considered favorably by the counities, considerable additional work will be required to expend these projects so that the logistics and personnel meeds can be projected.

There is also attached a list of possible projects not concerned with fallout that we would like to have discussed by the Mil staff.

The various laboratories should probably be asked to submit proposals or suggestions. Possibly this would be an appropriate subject to bring up at the Laboratory Directors Meeting at Brookhaven next month.
